Covid19 pandemic UOSNAD ASLNapoli3sud : preliminary comparison data Home Artificial Nutrition Prescription (HANP)
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BACKGROUND AND AIMS

The sudden appearance of SARSCOV2 has redesigned health care at all levels in the last two years. As GIMBE (1) publishes, during 2020 the number of services decreased: - 17% hospitalizations, -144.5 million specialist visits, 90.2% in public service.

METHODS

The UONAD of ASLNapoli3 provide home medical evaluations for assessment and treatment malnutrition.

The purpose of the study was to verify possible decline in performance by comparing registered patients data year 2018 (pre COVID19) (2), versus 2020 (pandemic beginning) and evaluate 2020 prescriptions in cancer and neurological patients .

RESULTS

6007 patients is registered from January 1st to 31 December 2020 , oncological (1337) 22.7%, neurological (3324) 55.3%

HANP :cancer patients: 57.2% ONS, 4.4% EN, 32.8% PN, 5.5% mixed ;

neurological patients: 74% ONS, 14.8% EN, 7.4% PN, 3.6% mixed

CONCLUSION

From preliminary data, 2020 UONAD register + 60% patients compared 2018 (registered 3695)(2), reduction -7,1% neurological patients, increase +12,1% cancer patients (2).

ONS is larghest prescribed in cancer and neurologic patients, followed EN in neurological and PN in oncological subgroup (3,4).
